The Antrim School Presents

A Painting I and an Invitational Painting II class. These are two, intensive, week long 50 plus hour workshops in August.

Dick Millard teaches in a manner that parallels that of the traditional, formal, and regimented concept of the classical apprenticeship, which has not existed in it's ideal since the 1960s. The format is a highly concentrated, and accelerated variation of an apprenticeship with six day increments of information and supervised practice. This to be practiced and refined further over the subsequent year until the following class sessions, to derive the utmost benefit.

For Painting I, brushes are provided for use during class but not included. They may however, be purchased at class completion. Attendees will provide their own brushes for techniques addressed in the Invitational Painting II class. All brushes are available from L. Reusche or from Millard Studios which maintains a limited supply for attendees. Invitational Painting II students must have completed Painting I. First time attendees of Painting I will follow prescribed curriculum. Others will Proceed with advanced curriculum commensurate with previous attendances.

I am an independent stained glass artist also doing freelance design and painting for stained glass studios throughout the U.S. and assisting other exceptional artists.


